Property Description

Located in a small hamlet above the village of Villard, this property has a great deal to offer, the existing living area is spacious and bright, with unspoilt views West down la vallee verte.

Built on a slope there are some interesting levels to deal with. On the main level, through the front door, is a corridor with access to the separate WC, bathroom and laundry area, then into the kitchen. From the kitchen there is the living/dining area of 22m2 with an external door into the garden. Two large adjoined bedrooms lead from the living area, both with beautiful views.

A door exists from the kitchen to the stables, continuing down the slope of the building there is another stable which leads to 2 'cellars'. In fact these are above ground, both have windows, one also has a door to the garden. Above all of these rooms is a large hayloft of approximately 180m2 with space to add yet another level.

The land of 1058m2 surrounds the farmhouse and with it there is a small storage barn with a lean to and a vaulted cellar beneath it. There is also a small grenier or mazot.

There is a large aga in the kitchen which can heat a couple of the radiators, otherwise electric radiators and/or poeles are the current option for heating. The electricity has been recently upgraded.

The hamlet itself comprises of a few buildings, mainly inhabited year round. The road finishes at this point, so there is no 'through' traffic.

For skiing it is 8 mins drive to Les Haberes and le massif des Brasses. Chamonix would be one hour, Samoens (Le grande massif) and Geneva airport would take about 50 mins. The town of Boege is only 5 mins away, it has a chemist, shops, bars, restaurants an outdoor pool, schools and a market on Tuesdays.
